Note: this event is not providing One Event Licence under this policy.

If you aren't a current licence holder you will need to obtain a licence from Motorcycling Australia and will be required to provide the following.

- Proof of Age (over 16 Yrs for senior licence)
- **Proof of Competency**. Proof of competency Road bike licence OR Copy of One Event Licence OR Practical and Theory Competency Test
- Proof of ambulance cover.
- Proof of current MA-affiliated Club Membership,
- To enter the event the rider will need to enter via the Ridernet portal.
